Principles and Commitment

- ❑ Our inclusion policy and school mission statement clearly outlines our commitment to inclusion and access. This plan will be presented to the governors' resources committee on a regular basis along with the buildings action plan.
- ❑ Our school welcomes its general responsibilities under the new Disability Equality Duty and we believe that diversity is a strength, which should be respected and celebrated by all those who learn, teach and visit here. At St Margaret's C.E. Primary School we are committed to ensuring equality of education and opportunity for disabled pupils, staff and all those receiving services from the school. We aim to develop a culture of diversity in which all feel free to disclose their disability and to participate fully in school life. The achievements of disabled pupils and students will be monitored and we will use this data to raise standards and ensure inclusive teaching. We will make reasonable adjustments to make sure that the school is accessible as possible.

- ❑ We have no member of staff with an admitted disability.
- ❑ In 2007 a disabled toilet and medical bay was fitted.
